The cross is a significant and familiar symbol in our faith. It can be found in many places and in many countries. It is a holy sign of God's love and a sign of Jesus' sacrifice.

Perhaps the most powerful symbol that has been reduced to having the least impression on us is the cross. However, the cross is a symbol of many things. It is a symbol of suffering and of death. It is the symbol of conquering death and the promise of eternal life through the Resurrection. The cross is also *hope*. It reminds us of being united with Jesus, but also calls for us to commit to live as people of God in the here and now. The cross is identity. It serves as a reminder to ourselves and to others of who we are; the body of the Church, followers of Christ. At St Mary's we can see the cross siting centrally on our school emblem. When we make the Sign of the Cross, it is a prayer and visible gesture by which we connect with both the Trinity; Father, Son and Holy Spirit, and the promise of eternal life.

Bishop Mark's homily during mass today reminded us of how we need to regularly turn to the cross. When we look to see Jesus on the Cross, we are guided to understand and connect with God. At times we focus too much on ourselves, on being successful, on being too comfortable, on the fear of losing someone, and it is in times like these that we need to turn to the cross. God made us and loves us. We are worth his life and his death.

Let us during this season of Lent, turn to the cross and turn to God's love.

COVID SAFETY UPDATE

School may adopt the following changes commencing 8 March 2021 in all schools:

- Parents and carers may enter the school to drop off and pick up students in accordance with local school arrangements.

- All visitors to a school site must comply with sign-in arrangements. This includes the requirement to sign the school sign-in sheet where they acknowledge that they will comply with the COVID-19 requirements for visitors, contractors and service providers each time they visit.

- School can welcome parents and carers to attend school sporting events and activities, whether indoors or outdoors, in line with the requirements in place for other <u>community</u> <u>sporting competitions and training activities</u>


