Pope Francis describes Saint Joseph as *a beloved father, a tender and loving father, an obedient father, an accepting father; a father who is creatively courageous, a working father, a father in the shadows*. From scripture we know that St. Joseph was a carpenter and taught the trade to Jesus. Joseph is not spoken of in scripture often, he appeared for the last time when Jesus was 12 years old and was found in the Temple.

St Joseph has a significant connection to our school and parish. St Mary's school began in the room behind Our Lady of Pompeii Church in Yoogali, in January 1949. St Mary's was founded by the religious order, the Sisters of St Joseph. In the early years, St Mary's students were educated solely by the Sisters of St Joseph. Until 1993 the sisters of St Joseph continued to be part of St Mary's staff, with Sister Rosalie Gannon RSJ, being the final religious principal of St Mary's.

We celebrate St. Joseph on March 19. It has been declared by the Pope as the 'Year of St Joseph'. He is the patron saint of the Universal Church, fathers, workers, travelers, and immigrants. Throughout the year we are encouraged to strive to honor St. Joseph as the guardian and protector of the Church, to take his virtuous and holy life as our model. Kinder and their Year 6 Buddies celebrated this feast day at our parish mass on Friday.

Through admiring his humble servant qualities we can strive to be more like St Joseph.

COVID SAFETY UPDATE
